PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

General

Alcoholic, ready-to-use hygienic hand disinfectant with bactericidal, levurocidal (yeast fungi) and limited virucidal (enveloped viruses) effect according to WHO formula. The product acts quickly and is relubricating.

Special properties and standards

- Authorisation as biocidal product for hand disinfection (product types 1).

73,4 % (73,4 g/100 g) ethanol
- The antimicrobial activity of the WHO formulation has been confirmed by the WHO reference test laboratories according to EN 1500.

- **EN 1276** (bactericidal): effectiveness against bacteria (*Staphylococcus aureus*, *Enterococcus hirae*, *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *E-Coli K12*) according to EN phase 2 / level 1 (suspension tests): 15 s, 30 s, 60 s at low contamination
- **EN 1650** (levurocidal): effectiveness against fungi (*Candida albicans*) according to EN phase 2 / stage 1 (suspension tests) 15s, 30 s, 60 s at low contamination
- Dermatologically tested
- The product is formulated without quaternary ammonium compounds, colorants and perfumes.



Application area

- Use for hand disinfection in private households, health care facilities, public institutions, industry and including companies associated with food production.

PROCESSING

Instructions for use

- Put a sufficiently large amount of the product in the palm of your hand (approx. 3 ml).
- Ensure complete wetting of the hands during the recommended exposure time of 30 sec.
- Rub on both hands up to the root of the hand. Also wet the back of


